SOILE YLI-MÄYRY

of Finland, a painter for more than 25 years, makes her paintings by using a palette knife. She uses paint in three ways: a thin, even coat, thick lines and by scraping lines into the painted area for a three-dimensional look. The main theme in Yli-Mäyry's work is humanity and people's alienation from nature in the urban world. Since her arts studies at the Arts Academy in Stuttgart in Germany (1972-75 she has had about 250 solo exhibitions in Japan, China, Hong Kong, Singapore, India, Latin America, United States, Dubai and in many countries in Europe.

Besides the career as painter Mrs. Yli-Mäyry studies political science and has taken her Licentiate's degree in Political Science at the University of Helsinki.

ALLAN MADSEN

was born in 1952 in Randers, Denmark. Between the years 1971 and 1981 he studied music in London. During this period he also started studying the art of drawing and moved to Paris 1981. After 7 years of art studies and hard work in Paris he left for Sweden in 1988 but today he lives and works from Spain.

Madsen uses the same technique in his artistry as the old 17th century masters where he first covers the canvas with a base color and then starts building the structure and motif. Disassociated, fragmented and reconstructed appear, in Madsen's work, the allegorical figures of Botticelli and Giotto, the masterly anatomical studies by Michelangelo and the airs of mystery and the ineffable and blurred figures of Leonardo. Madsen has exhibit his art in many countries worldwide as in USA, Canada, Ireland, Spain and Sweden.
